- SEGMENT ONE: School Board and Cabinet only**
- 8:45 AM **Opening Activity: DREAM BIG**

- Each participant takes a few minutes to finish this sentence by writing down three dreams they wish would come true for the school district this year. These are then posted on the walls. We review the statements, ask questions to better understand them, categorize them into challenges, and see how they overlap or can be narrowed into a set of Goals & Objectives as leaders.

- 10:00 am **Skill Building Session: Communicating Leadership**
- Brief presentation by Tom DeLapp on how interpersonal and group communication is the hydraulic fluid in education systems that drives organizational leadership and change management
- 10:30 AM **Team Building Session: Communication Protocols**
- Discussion of expectations and processes we use to communicate among trustees and within the leadership team. The outcome is to agree, even when we disagree, on how we communicate to and with each other. Norms of conduct, protocols, procedures, and standards will be identified and the group will be asked to sign off on these guiding leadership principles.
