Safety Plan

Addendum 2017-2018

Six school sites in Soledad Unified School District facilitate ASES, grant-funded, after-school programs. This safety plan addendum is to be included in each of the six sites safety plans from this day, Monday, January 26, 2018 and forward. These sites include: Main Street Middle School, San Vicente School, Gabilan School, Rose Ferrero School, Frank Ledesma School, & Jack Francioni School. Each sites safety plan will now include a section for the ASES Safety Plan.

After School Program Safety:

Walkers

To ensure safe travel home from the program, students that walk will be permitted to leave early due to standard time change.

- During the fall time change, students that walk, will be permitted to leave at 4:30 to ensure all walkers get home safely while there is still daylight.
- Walking students will be crossed at each major intersection nearest each school site.
- We advise younger students (grades 1st -3rd) be picked up. If students this young must walk home we recommend they are accompanied by an older sibling, friend, or fellow neighbor to ensure they arrive at home safely.

Bicycle Riding

- Riding bicycles to school is an excellent form of exercise and students need to wear proper safety equipment such as helmets and protective pads. Bikes must be locked in the appropriate area and may not be ridden.

Emergency Contacts

Please be sure to provide the after school program with the most current emergency contact information in case the program should need to get ahold of you regarding your students.

- Please provide new contact information if there is a change.
- Provide more than one emergency contact as the after school program will make every effort to contact parents/ guardians, and other contacts based on the information provided the program.

Emergency Drills

Regular emergency drills will be conducted throughout the year to make sure students know what to do in the event of an emergency.

Drills include practice of:

- Fire Drills
- Earthquake Drills
- Shelter in Place/ Stranger on Campus

Fire and earthquake drills will include the necessary steps, including duck and cover practice (earthquake) and evacuation of room (fire & earthquake) outside to designated area (blacktop or field areas).

After School Program Rules

Additionally, after school program students are expected to follow their sites PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention & Support) school rules as well as general after school program rules to ensure the safety of all students in all educational settings (see general after school rules printed in this handbook and visit / ask the school site for a copy of your student's school PBIS school rules)
