Districting Process

Step	Description	
Two Initial Hearings Oct. 12 & Nov. 9	Held prior to release of draft maps. Education and to solicit input on the communities in the Districts.	
Two Draft Map Hearings Jan. 11 & Feb. 8	Two Public Hearings to discuss and revise the draft maps and to discuss the election sequence. Draft maps must be posted at least 7 days before they are considered by the Board.	
Map Selected by Board Feb. 22	Selection of Board's preferred map.	
Map Adoption by County Committee By March 13	After Board adoption, the County Committee on School District Organization holds a hearing and votes on final approval.	






